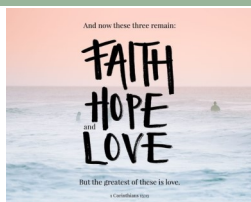

Research has shown that more than 40 percent of all cancers diagnosed and nearly half of all deaths from cancer in the United States can be attributed to preventable causes – things like smoking, excess body weight, physical inactivity, and excessive exposure to the sun.

As a result, steps such as quitting smoking (or never starting in the first place), maintaining a healthy weight, exercising regularly, protecting your skin from the sun, and getting vaccinated against the pathogens that cause certain cancers can dramatically reduce your risk of certain cancers.

*2022 World Day of the Sick Message*



In his 2022 message for World Day of the Sick, Pope Francis reaffirms “the importance of Catholic health care institutions” as “a precious treasure to be protected and preserved” and whose presence has shown the church’s “closeness to the sick and the poor, and to situations overlooked by others.”

He reminds us that Jesus’ invitation to be merciful like the Father has particular significance for health care workers, saying: “I think of all those physicians, nurses,

Be mindful of the great dignity of your profession, as well as the responsibility that it entails.”

*As we remember and pray for all those who are sick in this world, we call to mind our mission as men and women who have committed our varied gifts and talents to helping our brothers and sisters who suffer all forms of illness. Let us not forget the many steps along the way to healing. Let us be gentle with ourselves when we find that we too have become ill.*
