

COVID-19 UPDATE

As of September 30, Maryhill is NOT considered in outbreak status.

You can check our website for the most up-to-date information re: Maryhill's COVID status. In the event of a new outbreak, we will contact all families via phone or text (if you have opted to receive notifications via text). Alzheimer's held in Green Bay on Saturday, 9/24! They came in 2nd place for company donations. You can still donate until the end of the year!




