COVID-19 UPDATE

As of September 30, Maryhill is NOT considered in outbreak status.

You can check our website for the most up-to-date information re: Maryhill's COVID status. In the event of a new outbreak, we will contact all families via phone or text (if you have opted to receive notifications via text). If your loved one is directly affected, we will always call you with any information. We will never text personal information.

- Please practice good hand hygiene.
- Please refrain from wandering around facility - we ask that you try to stay in the residents room or reserved area.

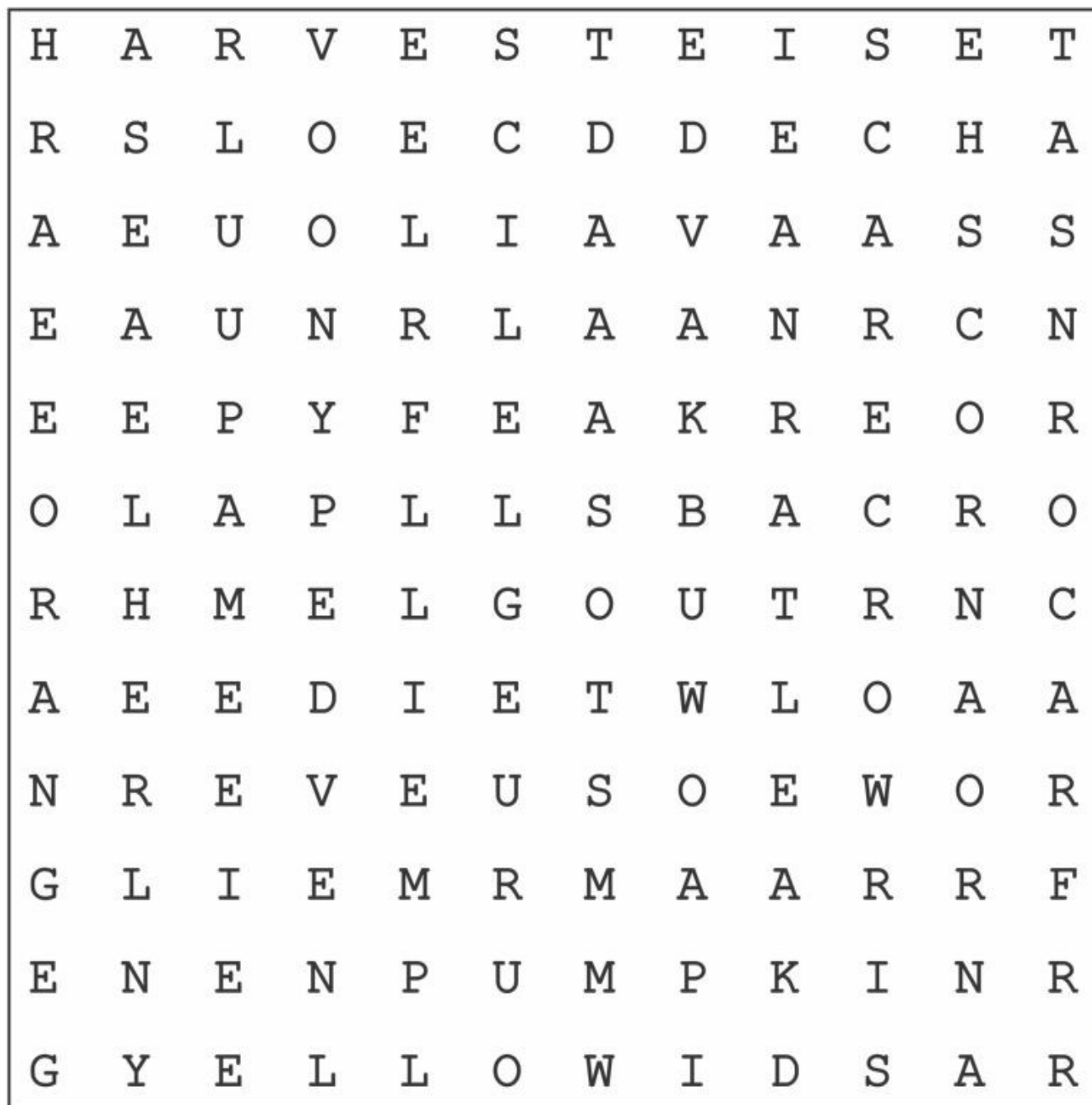
Prayer of St. Francis of Assisi (Prayer for Peace)
