Just a reminder that when you take your loved one out of the facility for an outing, please remember to notify their nurse. It is imperative that we know when residents leave and return from the facility.



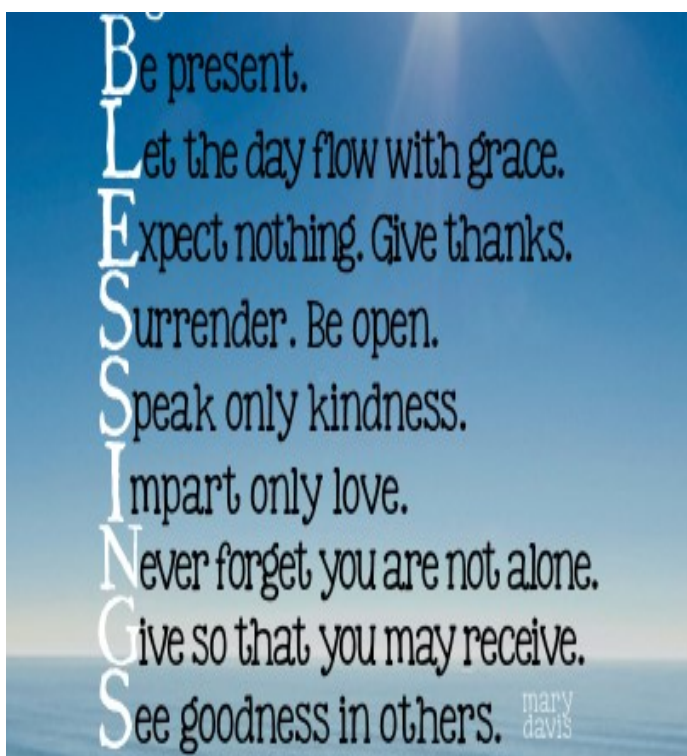

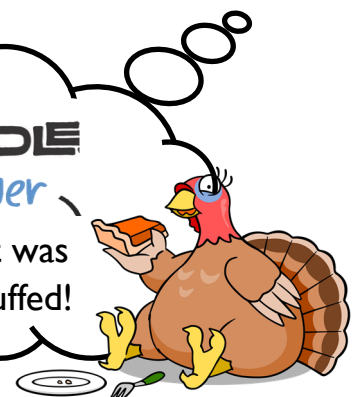

PRAYER TO SAINT TERESA OF CALCUTTA

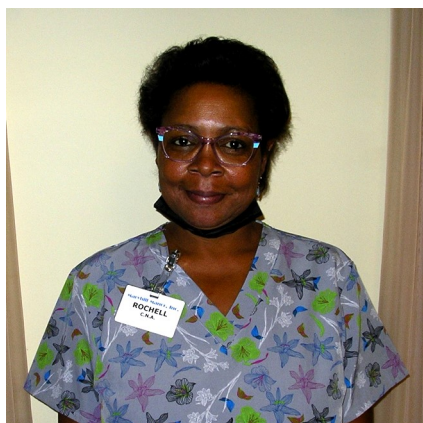

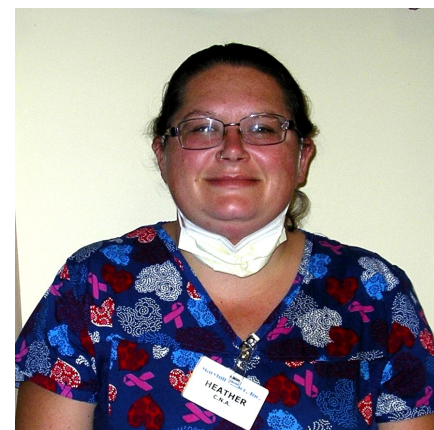

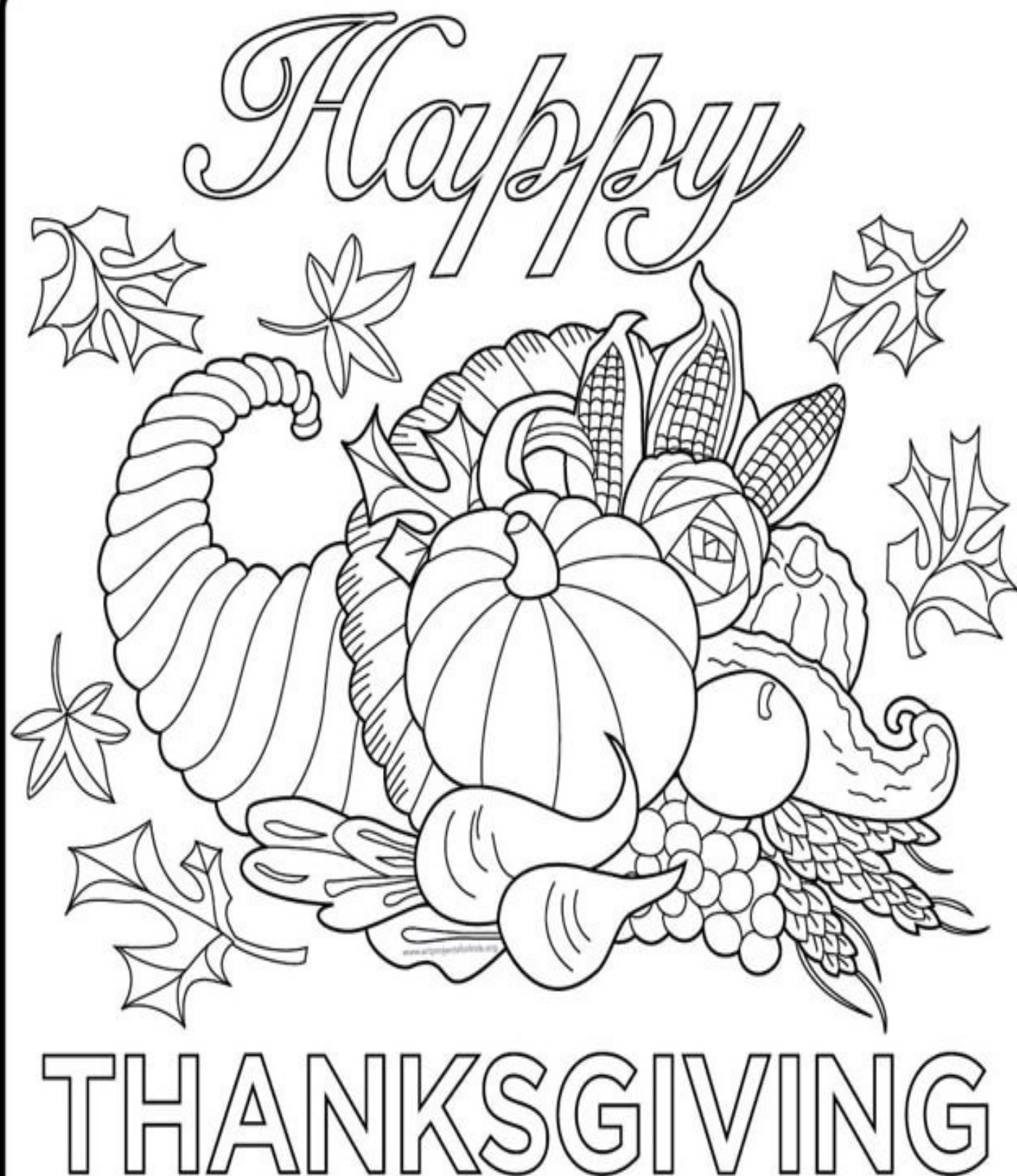
